Hello!


I thought you might like to know a bit about me, so you know who I am and what I do.

I work as a Young Person Advisor for 16–25-year-old young people with special educational needs and/or disabilities who live in West Sussex. I like spending time with my family, walking in the countryside and going on holidays, especially to France.

How I can help you:

- help if you need more support at school or college
- support you if you find it difficult to tell people what you think and feel
- give you information about what you could do next, such as by suggesting websites or services and giving you contacts and ideas.

It will be up to you to decide what to do, once you have talked it over with people who care about you. I won't tell you what to do, only what your choices are.



Before I did this job, I was a teacher and a SENCO (Special Educational Needs and Disabilities Coordinator) in a secondary school with a sixth form. I have also worked as a Job Coach, supporting young adults in their Supported Internships.
